On Sunday we continued our series based on the book of Hebrews entitled **Consider Jesus**.

Key Passage: Hebrews 5:1-10

From the passage above we looked at what sets Jesus apart from ever other high priest in the Old Testament and what this means in terms of our salvation.

1. How aware are you on a day-to-day basis of your need of a great high priest?
2. In moments when you know you've messed up big time do you tend to run from or run to God?
3. Because Jesus never sinned He is the only high priest who has never had to make sacrifice for His own sin. Why is it important for us to understand that because of this Jesus not only died for us but also lived for us?
4. How does this affect the way in which we view our relationship with God and in particular deal with moments of despair?
